

Reflection on the Liturgy of the Word

Our first reading, from the Book of Genesis, gives us a context for the Gospel. By providing hospitality to the three travelers, Abraham and Sarah are prepared to listen to the message that they bring. Martha, on the other hand, provides Jesus the hospitality their culture expects but is so busy about it that she forgets to listen. She is so much about “*doing*” that Luke describes her as “*burdened*” by all the service she performs. Her words disclose her obvious frustration with her sister, Mary and her disappointment that the Lord does not seem to care that Mary remains unhelpful. In his response the Lord calmly acknowledges Martha’s anxiety and creates a hierarchy in which Mary’s way of being is preferred to Martha’s frenzied service. One might wonder whether Martha, in her anxious state, would even have been able to hear what the Lord was saying. The point is to listen to the Word of the Lord so that it leads to acts of service. When the Lord speaks we must first, like Mary, open ourselves to hear. We must provide a welcoming place in our hearts to listen at the feet of Jesus then we can be more charitable and hospitable to those whom we meet. Let us invite the Lord into our hearts as we listen to God’s Word, praying like St. Paul, that the Word of God may be brought to completion in us.



Humans love to negotiate and Abraham is no exception. In the first reading he confidently engages in a lengthy process of bargaining with the Lord, for the safety of the innocent, intending to test the boundaries of the Lord’s mercy and patience. What he finds out is that the Lord’s mercy is available for all who seek and ask, even for one. Being persistent in prayer is a message reinforced in the Gospel, that God will listen to those who persist in prayer. The parable about a friend in need emphasizes this persistence and provides a direct link to Abraham’s persistent questioning of God. *Ask/receive, seek/find, knock/open* are the elements of Jesus’ own teaching on prayer. The request of one of his disciples: “*Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples*” was an ordinary one for it was customary for disciples to learn how to pray from their leader. Jesus responds simply by inviting the disciples to learn and share in the prayer we know as the Our Father. Luke’s version has five petitions addressing God as “*Father*” blessing God’s name as we pray for “*your kingdom to come*”. “*Daily bread*” includes both physical and spiritual sustenance. Praying to God to “*forgive us our sins*” and to bring us to “*forgive everyone in debt to us*”. The final petition “*do not subject us to the final test*” asks that God spare us from the time of trial before the end of this age. The Gospel ends by Jesus promising the Holy Spirit to all who ask. Jesus is teaching that God universally provides in this world and the next.



James, his brother John (the sons of Zebedee) and Peter were special favorites of the Lord. They had the privilege of witnessing the Transfiguration. James was called “the Greater” because he was older than the other Apostle named James. The two of them are the ones who told the Lord that they thought they deserved a special place in his kingdom. They bragged that they would be able to sacrifice their lives, as Jesus was going to sacrifice his. Jesus took the brothers aside. He told them that they did not understand what true service to others meant. He said that anyone who wanted to be truly great had to be the servant of others. Jesus was trying to teach them what he expected of them.

Jesus called the two brothers “sons of thunder” because they sometimes lost their tempers. One time the people of a village turned them away. James and John were upset that the villagers would not welcome Jesus. They asked the Lord if he wanted them to call down fire to destroy the village. Jesus had to correct them and remind them that God wants us to act with love. But

James and John did learn from everything Jesus taught. They became great examples of faith for all of Jesus’ followers. After Pentecost, James stayed in Jerusalem to preach about Jesus even though it was dangerous to be known as a Christian. He was soon arrested and put to death. James was the first Apostle to become a martyr for his faith in Christ. James’ life reminds us that, if we ask him, Jesus will help us to change our bad habits and grow in living as his disciples. The body of James is venerated in the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Spain. James, also has a special relationship to our Diocese, the first Church dedicated on Long Island 200 years ago is named for St. James.

¿Qué es un santo?

Los santos nos parecen a menudo seres separados, inalcanzables, que revolotean en las altas esferas de la perfección. Y sin embargo, son hombres y mujeres como nosotros : "*Los santos no son héroes, superhombres, como Napoleón, Tutankamón o Tarzán.*

Son hombres y mujeres corrientes que han dicho sí a Dios. Sólo Dios es santo, es la santidad. Y los santos, como dijo San Pablo, son sólo un reflejo de su gloria. Son aventureros de lo esencial. Se entregan a Dios y permiten que los invada. Un poco como Abraham.

No sabemos realmente a dónde vamos; si lo supiéramos, no nos iríamos. Tienes que entregarte a Dios primero. En la primera parte de su vida, Vicente de Paúl trató de poner a Dios en su negocio, para hacer una buena carrera. Entonces se entrega a Dios. Y es él quien se pone en los asuntos de Dios.

Los santos son sólo hombres, con sus defectos, sus debilidades.

San Pablo es un dolor de cabeza, insopportable. San Pedro siempre está metiendo la pata. No son hombres perfectos. Están llamados a la perfección, a la santidad, como todos nosotros. Hay algo divino en cada hombre. De vez en cuando, la Iglesia designa a tal o cual persona. Hoy pensamos en el Abbé Pierre o en la Madre Teresa.

Pero eso no significa que una hermanita que lleva sesenta años cocinando en su convento y a la que nadie conoce no sea también una santa. La Iglesia propone "**modelos superiores**", por así decirlo. No debemos imitarlos tal como son, sino inspirarnos en ellos. A quien debemos imitar es a Cristo, como los santos trataron de imitarlo. Es una llamada. Nosotros lo contestamos. O no. Con la condición de no olvidar nunca a Dios. El único modelo es Cristo.

Por qué la Iglesia celebra a María Magdalena?

Por decisión del Papa Francisco, Santa María Magdalena es ahora celebrada por toda la Iglesia Católica el 22 de julio.

"*María Magdalena es un ejemplo de verdadera y auténtica evangelizadora*", dijo. Es una forma de honrar al "**apóstol de los apóstoles**" y a las mujeres discípulas de Jesús.

Como primera testigo de la tumba vacía en la mañana de Pascua, la primera en anunciar la resurrección de Cristo a los apóstoles, Santa María Magdalena tuvo un papel pionero en la Iglesia.

Cumplió la misión que le había encomendado el Resucitado: "Ve a mis hermanos y diles... María Magdalena fue y dijo a los discípulos: "*He visto al Señor*", y les contó lo que le había dicho" (Jn 20,17-18). De este modo se convierte, como ya hemos señalado, en una evangelista, es decir, en una mensajera que anuncia la buena noticia de la resurrección del Señor [...].

Es testigo de Cristo resucitado y anuncia el mensaje de la resurrección del Señor, como los demás apóstoles. Por tanto, es justo que la celebración litúrgica de esta mujer tenga el mismo grado de festividad que el otorgado a la celebración de los apóstoles en el calendario general romano, y que se resalte la misión de esta mujer, que es ejemplo y modelo para toda mujer en la Iglesia.

María Magdalena es un ejemplo de verdadera y auténtica evangelista, es decir, una evangelista que anuncia el alegre mensaje central de la Pascua.




