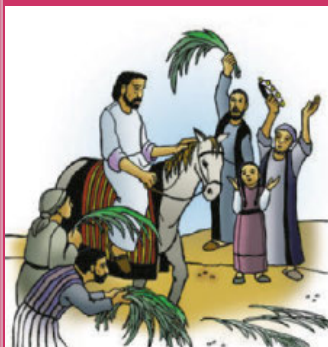

Scripture Readings for **PALM**  
**SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE**  
**LORD**

Preview of readings:

We greet the Lord with palm  
branches and hosannas, welcoming  
him into the holy city of Jerusalem. His  
missionary journey and our Lenten  
journey are nearing their completion.

In Holy Week Jesus will celebrate the Passover, go to the garden  
to pray, be arrested, put on trial and be sentenced to death. He  
will die on the cross, be taken down and buried, Jesus will be  
raised from the tomb and the glory of Easter begins.

For our Palm Sunday readings we reflect on the powerful words  
of the Scriptures; from the suffering servant of the prophet  
Isaiah who speaks to the weary, the Psalmist who cries out "My  
God, my God, why have you abandoned me?", to St. Paul who tells  
us how Jesus emptied himself and accepted death on a cross and  
the Passion according to St. Matthew where we experience what  
our Lord endured to win our salvation.

On the Fifth Sunday, when the resurrection of Lazarus is proclaimed, we are faced with the ultimate mystery of our existence: *"I am the resurrection and the life... Do you believe this?"* (Jn 11: 25-26) For the Christian community, it is the moment to place with sincerity - together with Martha - all of our hopes in Jesus of Nazareth: *"Yes, Lord, I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is to come into the world"* (Jn 11: 27) Communion with Christ in this life prepares us to overcome the barrier of death, so that we may live eternally with him. Faith in the resurrection of the dead and hope in eternal life open our eyes to the ultimate meaning of our existence: God created men and women for resurrection and life and this truth gives an authentic and definitive meaning to human history, to the personal and social lives of men and women, to culture, politics and the economy. Without the light of faith, the entire universe finishes shut within a tomb devoid of any future, any hope. We need to hear the words of Jesus who bid *"Lazarus, come out!"* And when he came out bound in the burial clothes, Jesus said: *"Untie him, and let him go!"* From what do we need

to be unbound? Have our Lenten sacrifices and penances freed us from sin and death to rise with Jesus this Easter? Which of our Lenten practices will we carry over into our lives after Easter?

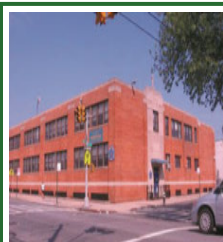

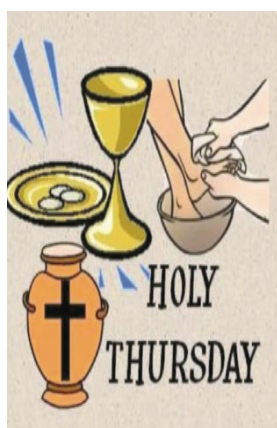
