Reflection on the Liturgy of the Word

I pray for them: ... I am not in the world any longer; but they are in the world and I am coming to You.

John 17

his Seventh Sunday of Easter sets the tone for next week's L Pentecost Sunday as we read in the Acts of the Apostles of Mary, the Apostles and other followers waiting in the Upper Room after the Ascension. We are told "All these devoted themselves with one accord to prayer." In John's Gospel, Jesus prays to the Father claiming us as his own: "I revealed your name to those whom you gave me out of the world. The belonged to you and you gave them to me". As part of this farewell discourse Jesus warns his disciples that they will be scattered and says they will find trouble in the world but assures them he has conquered the world. Jesus' prayer reflects the passionate, inseparable nature between him and his Father. "I glorified you on earth by accomplishing the work that you gave me to do. I speak this in the world so that they may share my joy completely. Father, they are your gift to me, I wish that where I am they also may be with me." Jesus seeks to strengthen his disciples for the task of remaining in him after he is gone from the world. Jesus prays for himself to glorify the Father's name and for his disciples tp persevere in the world. We see the challenge Jesus will present to Peter as we end our weekday Easter Season readings with the conclusion of John's Gospel. Jesus asks Peter three times to "feed and tend my sheep". John ends his Gospel with these words: "There are also many other things that Jesus did, but if they were to be described individually, I do not think the whole world would contain the books that would be written." Next weekend on Pentecost the readings and the whole Church will celebrate the coming and ongoing presence of the Holy Spirit among us. Jesus breathes on his Apostles and tells them, "Receive the Holy Spirit" and says to them "Peace be with you" this fills them with courage to fulfill Jesus' command to go into the whole world and proclaim the Good News.




