esus in the Gospel today tells us that he came precisely so that we may live a Julife of peace and happiness: "I have come so that they may have life and have it more abundantly." As we listen to these words of Jesus they take on added meaning because we are in the Easter Season. We have celebrated Jesus' death and resurrection. Jesus had to die to himself to live his new life. Jesus has shown us how to live life to the fullest, we must die to ourselves in order to rise to new life. Our secularized world thinks it has the answer to our needs but what it offers only leads us into deeper despair. Only dying to ourselves as we follow Jesus will lead us to the happiness we seek. Jesus teaches us that the way to happiness lies not in filling up each of our wants and needs and desires. The way to happiness lies in a very different choice of life; in sacrificing and taking up our cross with Jesus, reproducing the life of Jesus in our own lives. And so Jesus says, I am the gate. Anyone who enters through me will be safe: he will go freely in and out and be sure of finding pasture...Saint John Paul II encouraged people many times to find life to the full by following Jesus as he said words like this, "Do not be afraid to open the doors to Christ..." In Palestine the shepherd brought the

sheep into the sheepfold every night. It was a circular stone wall with an opening or door where the sheep entered. Once the sheep were inside for the night the shepherd slept in that opening or door all night. The sheep could not get out without stepping over the shepherd's body which meant they would not get out at all during the night. Jesus is the gate, anyone who enters through him will be safe, and will go freely in and out and be sure of finding pasture. Others steal and kill and destroy but Jesus is the Good Shepherd. As we contemplate Jesus the Good Shepherd on this Day of Prayer for Vocations, we are mindful of the words of Pope Francis who reminds us: "No vocation is born of itself or lives for itself. A vocation flows from the heart of God and blossoms in the good soil of faithful people, in the experience of fraternal love". Let us pray that many may listen to the voice of Jesus as he calls, that they may enter the sheepfold through him and be safe and have life and live it to the fullest.



n 1963, Pope Saint Paul VI designated Good Shepherd Sunday as *World Day of Prayer for Vocations* (WDPV). Christ Jesus, the Good Shepherd, knows us well and gives his life for us. In the name of Christ Jesus we rejoice in the Good Shepherd who leads us into fullness of life. The purpose of this day is to publically fulfill the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers

into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). Please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate, religious life, societies of apostolic life or secular institutes



TODAY IS KNOWN AS GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY in each year of the liturgical cycle on this 4th Sunday of Easter, the Gospel is always taken from the 10th chapter of John where Jesus speaks of himself as the Good Shepherd. Jesus says: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them and they follow me, I give them eternal life and they shall never perish." Jesus knows his sheep and they know him. There is a mutual bond of love and intimacy. That love is compared to the deep mutual relationship that exists between Jesus and his Father, "The Father and I are one" and with Jesus and the Church. Why today is also a WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS, we are reminded, as baptized Catholics and all Christians, that our central vocation is both a call to holiness and to service. "Holiness is the vocation of our times, of all of us," said Saint Paul VI in Vatican Council II. Saint John Paul II constantly called upon young people and all of us to give our lives in service as followers of Jesus Christ. And Pope Francis gives a reminder of this in his example of service for all people, especially the poor.

Prayer for Vocations

Generous God, you show us the way that leads to everlasting life. Through baptism you have called us to proclaim the Good News. Bless and strengthen those who have made a commitment of service in the Church. Guide and give wisdom to those discerning their vocation. Enrich our Church with dedicated married and single people, with Priests, Deacons and with people in Consecrated Life. Filled with your Holy Spirit we ask this blessing that we, your people, may follow Jesus, our Good Shepherd, now and always. Amen.




