This Feast is given to us as a way to honor our Christian Family. As we honor the Holy Family we focus on our own families and consider how we can be like them. The reading from Sirach and St. Paul concentrate on the family and our calling to treat each other as believers and as Christians. The Gospel portrays the devotion of Mary and Joseph traveling to Jerusalem to present Jesus to God. Let this Holy Feast remind us that we are the family of God gathered in faith. A family with joys and sorrows, triumphs and sins. A family that prays and celebrates together.

SOLEMNITY OF MARY: Today we combine several celebrations: The blessing of our New Year, A World Day of Prayer for Peace, The end of the Octave of Christmas and Honoring Mary as the Holy Mother of God. The Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace!








NEW YEAR'S BLESSING PRAYER FOR CLOCKS AND CALENDARS


