

Praying and discussing the Scripture Readings for PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

His missionary journey and our Lenten journey are nearing their completion. In Holy Week Jesus will celebrate the Passover, go to the garden to pray, be arrested, put on trial and be sentenced to death. He will die on the cross, be taken down and buried, Jesus will be raised from the tomb and the glory of Easter begins.

In our readings we reflect on the powerful words of the Scriptures; from the suffering servant of the prophet Isaiah who speaks to the weary, the Psalmist who cries out "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?", to St. Paul who tells us how Jesus emptied himself and accepted death on a cross and the Passion according to St. Mark where we xperience what our Lord endured to win our salvation.



As we gather to celebrate our last Sunday Lenten Liturgy we renew our commitment to the New Covenant. The law of this covenant God has written upon our hearts. Let us resolve once again to die to sin and live in faith, obedient to the Son who, *lifted up from the earth*, draws us and everyone to himself.

In our first reading throughout this season we have been listening to covenant stories that took us back into Israel's history. Today we conclude our "covenant journey" with Jeremiah's oracle promising a new and eternal covenant. We look forward to the covenant that is offered in every age to those who, like the Greeks in the Gospel, "would like to see Jesus". In keeping with Lent's call to conversion and purification, the second reading from Hebrews reminds us that we must be prepared to learn obedience through suffering, as Jesus did. Even so, the Gospel resounds with hope, for the seed that dies bears rich fruit: "unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies it produces much fruit." A life sacrificed in loving service blossoms into eternal life and Jesus lifted from the earth draws everyone to himself. May these Scriptures prepare us to complete our Lenten observance and enter Holy Week with renewed dedication.




