

CHRIST BLESSING LITTLE CHILDREN

n this Respect Life Sunday, we renew our pledge to preserve and protect the dignity of all human life from conception to natural death. Gathered as Jesus' disciples, let us ask God to make us convincing witnesses to the sanctity of human life and to joy of faith in Jesus. As part of a network of human relationships we are called anew to honor these relationships with our spouse, our children, our neighbors and friends, knowing that God is always a part of them. We are reminded that God brought life to us all. Out of love and empathy for the first human, God created the first woman. God has blessed us with the ability to share in the creation of new life and we are called to exercise this blessing with care and respect.

Today's second reading begins a two-month series from the Letter to the Hebrews. Jesus is presented as our leader and brother whose sacrificial love opens for us the way to salvation. In the Gospel Jesus reflects on the beautiful example of sacrificial love, the lifelong commitment of marriage, the foundational relationship of human society, the faithful love between a man and a woman. It is the living image of Jesus' love for his bride, the Church. "The two of them become one flesh...therefore what God has joined together no human being must separate".

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY: THE MONTH OF OCTOBER DEDICATED TO MARY




On October 7th, the Roman Catholic Church celebrates the yearly feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honor of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was invoked on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe. Pope Leo XIII was particularly devoted to Our Lady of the Rosary, producing 11 encyclicals on the subject of this feast and its importance in the course of his long pontificate. "This devotion, so great and so confident, to the august Queen of Heaven," Pope Leo continued, "has never shone forth with such brilliancy as when the militant Church of God has seemed to be endangered by the violence of heresy ... or by an intolerable moral corruption, or by the attacks of powerful enemies." Foremost among such "attacks" was the battle of Lepanto, a perilous and decisive moment in European and world

WITH THE FIRST SUNDAY OBSERVED AS RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY

As Catholics, we are called to cherish, defend, and protect those who are most vulnerable, from the beginning of life to its end, and at every point in between



We are living in an exciting time of revival. Our National Eucharistic Congress, and the Eucharistic processions that led to it, involved hundreds of thousands of Catholics who will never be the same. The revival continues, and is so needed, especially in our efforts to defend human life. Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist, gives us the fullness of life. He calls each of us to respect that gift of life in every human person. While we live in a society that often rejects those who are weak, fragile, or vulnerable, they are the most in need of our care and protection. Pope Francis reminds us that "every child who, rather than being born, is condemned unjustly to being aborted, bears the face of Jesus Christ, bears the face of the Lord, who even before he was born, and then just after birth, experienced the world's rejection."

The 2024 Respect Life poster features the Eucharist and Jesus' message in John 10:10, "I came so that they might have life." The placement of "Respect Life" beneath the verse conveys that Jesus' message and our response to it inherently include respect for human life. The design also reflects the importance of grounding efforts on behalf of life in the Eucharist.


