



Reflection on the Liturgy of the Word



First Reading *Numbers 11:25-29* The Lord bestows his spirit on the seventy elders

Responsorial Psalm *Psalm 19:8,10,12-13,14* The Law of the Lord brings joy

Second Reading James 5:1-6 James chastises the rich

Gospel Reading *Mark 9:38-43,45,47-48* Jesus teaches that whoever is not against him is for him

As we enter into our season of Autumn, workers here at home and throughout the world are harvesting the fields to provide food for our tables. How appropriate in this Sunday's Liturgy while Jesus calls us to personal integrity: *"There is no one who performs a mighty deed in my name who can at the same time speak ill of me"*, St. James reminds us that as Jesus' disciples we must be committed to seeking justice for all God's children. As we celebrate this Eucharist, fulfilling our duty to worship God, let us renew our commitment to fulfill our duty of justice toward our neighbor.

We continue to listen to this section of Mark's Gospel in which Jesus teaches about discipleship. He calls his disciples to serve, teach and even challenge others, but not to judge their motives. The community of disciples, the Church, must judge right from wrong and prophetically produce the truth. In the Book of Numbers, Moses far from objecting, rejoices that God's Spirit has been bestowed outside his inner circle. Jesus too teaches us to rejoice whenever we find goodness, healing and compassion. Rather than judging others, we should examine the quality of our commitment. A crucial aspect of which, St. James tells us, is found in our love of neighbor

THE BLESSING OF ANIMALS: This custom is celebrated in remembrance of St. Francis of Assisi's



love for all God's creatures. Francis, whose feast day is October 4th, loved the larks flying about his hilltop town. Francis wrote a Canticle of the Creatures, an ode to God's living things. "All praise to you, O Lord, for all these brother and sister creatures." And there was testimony in the cause for St. Clare of Assisi's canonization that referred to her little cat! The bond between person and pet is like no other relationship, because the communication between fellow creatures is at its most basic. Eye-to-eye, a man and his dog, or a woman and her cat, are two creatures of love. No wonder people enjoy the opportunity to take their animal companions to church for a special blessing. TODAY THE CHURCH REMEMBERS THE FEAST OF THE ARCHANGELS. THERE IS NO LITURGICAL CELEBRATION BECAUSE WE CELEBRATE THE SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME MASS

Michael (Daniel 10:13), which means "Who is Like God?"; Gabriel (Daniel 8:16), which means "Power of God"; and Raphael (Tobit 7:8), which means "God has Healed." These named beings were later identified by Catholic tradition as "Archangels". These personal names tell us something about the nature of God. The Roman calendar sets aside two feast days to honor God's invisible servants. In the wake of the Second Vatican Council's reform of the Sacred Liturgy, we continue to celebrate the Feasts of the Archangels and of the Holy Guardian Angels. The Feast Day of the Archangels is celebrates on September 29th, was first approved by the

Lateran Council in 745. The Feast Day of the Guardian Angels, celebrated on October 2nd, originated in 1411 at Valencia, Spain. The liturgical celebration of these two feast days makes us mindful of our communion with the angels and of the immense expanse of the Church, which encompasses heaven and earth. The Opening Prayer for the Feast of the Archangels emphasizes the universal scope of God's providence: "O God who dispose in marvelous order ministries both angelic and human, graciously grant that our life on earth may be defended by those who watch over us as they minister perpetually to you in heaven."

Angel of God, my guardian dear to whom God's love commits me here. Ever this day/night be at my side to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.



"For God commands the angels to guard you in all your ways. With their hands they shall support you, lest you strike your foot against a stone." (Psalm 91:11-12)

God chose to create angels as mediators of His grace and care. It's fair to say that our Guardian Angels love us with a perfect love. They know us, care for us and desire deeply that we become holy. Their primary purpose is to get us to Heaven and to draw us into the heights of sanctity.


