First Reading *Wisdom 2:12,17-20*

The just one is put to the test.

Responsorial Psalm *Psalm 54:3-4,5,6 & 8*

Second Reading *James 3:16—4:3*

James teaches about the wisdom from above.

Gospel Reading *Mark 9:30-37*

Jesus teaches his disciples that the greatest are those who serve all.

From the midst of life's journey with its countless demands, we come as God's holy people, to the Table of the Word and Sacrament. We come remembering that wherever else our daily lives may take us we are always following Christ "on the way" of discipleship. The readings

present the image of the "just one", from the Book of Wisdom, who faces the violence of human treachery with gentle, patient trust in divine deliverance. As St. James challenges us to replace jealousy and selfish ambition with righteousness and peace. Jesus crowns these lessons by continuing to teach us that discipleship requires us to trust in God and to follow Jesus on the way of self-sacrificing love, setting aside all desire to be first or greatest and instead making ourselves last in childlike service to all. Having the attitude and quality of a child: powerlessness, vulnerability, openness, wonder and the capacity to be formed, taught and disciplined. To this select group of disciples, Jesus teaches that those who would be first in God's kingdom must be servants of all. Jesus then calls forward a child and teaches the Twelve that to receive a child in Jesus' name is to receive both Jesus and the One who sent him. We might easily fail to understand the significance of this action. In first-century Palestine, children were without status or power, possessing no legal rights. In this action, Jesus is teaching his disciples and us that when we serve the least ones among us, we serve Jesus himself. Who are the people without power or status in our society that Jesus is calling us to serve? Do we do so willingly? Jesus teaches that God's judgment of us will be based on this criterion alone




This Monday Feast of St. Padre Pio

Born in 1887 as Francesco Forgione in the small southern Italian village of Pietrelcina. A Capuchin priest who had received the stigmata, he spent fifty years at the monastery of San Giovanni Rotondo, where he was much sought after as a spiritual advisor, confessor and intercessor. Despite such notoriety, he would often say, "I only want to be a poor friar who prays". His life was devoted to the Eucharist and to prayer.

He died, September 23, 1968 at the age of eight-one.

Canonized on June 16, 2002 Feast Day: September 23rd



THE BLESSING OF ANIMALS: This custom is celebrated in remembrance of St. Francis of Assisi's love for all God's creatures. Francis, whose feast day is October 4th, loved the larks flying about his hilltop town. Francis wrote a Canticle of the Creatures, an ode to God's living things. "All praise to you, O Lord, for all these brother and sister creatures." And there was testimony in the cause for St. Clare of Assisi's canonization that referred to her little cat! The bond between person and pet is like no other relationship, because the communication between fellow creatures is at its most basic. Eye-to-eye, a man and his dog, or a woman and her cat, are two creatures of love. No wonder people enjoy the opportunity to take their animal companions to church for a special blessing. 




